

# Climate change is forcing schools to close early for 'heat days'

With no air conditioning and no money to install it, districts are sending students home

The study estimated that by 2025, more than 13,700 schools will need to install air conditioning, and an additional 13,500 will need to upgrade existing systems. Nationally, that amounts to about 1 in 4 public schools.
