BCEEs, BCEEMs, or BCESs have the option of successfully completing the Oral Examination in their certified specialty every two years in lieu of accumulating PDHs to maintain certification. If more than 40 PDHs are earned in any two-year certification period, up to 20 PDHs may be carried over into the succeeding two-year certification period.
